

Pisanki/Pysanky Easter Egg Decoration Workshops 2023

We invite you to join a Pisanki/Pysanky egg painting workshop led by Agata Radna. Come and learn to decorate an Easter egg using the ancient Polish/Ukrainian technique of Pisanki. The art of intricately decorating eggs for Easter has been a tradition in Eastern Europe dating back to Pagan times. The batik style of egg decoration uses wax and dye and is a tradition passed on for centuries. This workshop will demonstrate this technique and all participants will leave the workshop with 2 decorated eggs that can be kept forever.

About the workshop

Decorating Pisanki is a fun activity suitable for anyone to enjoy, and this workshop is suitable for those with no previous experience. No special skills are required, however due to the use of hot wax and candles, it is not suitable for those under the age of 14. All materials, egg shells, dyes and patterns required to make Pisanki will be provided. Workshop will run for 3 hours. Cost of the Workshop is \$34 per person.

On the day:

- Please wear old clothes as dye may stain clothes, bring an apron if desired.
- All materials will be provided, and each participant will have the opportunity to decorate 2 eggs.
- Due to use of hot wax and candles, this workshop is not suitable for those under the age of 14.
